CONSIGNMENT REQUIREMENTS

1. Horses must be at least 3 years old by January 1, 2012 (horses born prior to January 2009).
2. Horses may be geldings or open mares.
3. All Sellers must guarantee their horses are SOUND.
4. **All consignments must include the catalog fee of \$100.00, pictures and the signed consignment contract.** The sale committee will review all horse consignment submittals on each horse before horse is accepted into the sale. The catalog fee is non-refundable once the horse(s) is accepted into the sale.
5. **The catalog deadline is June 15, 2012.** Please submit 2 to 3 good quality pictures of your horse via email to Laurie Boner at lleis@hughes.net. If you are unable to send pictures via email, please mail them to Central Wyoming Livestock, PO Box 1810, Glenrock, WY 82637. Catalogs will be available mid July. Central Wyoming Livestock will advertise extensively. You are encouraged to submit your consignments as soon as possible to be included in any advertising done outside of the catalog.
6. The **horse preview** will be held at the Central Wyoming Livestock arena starting at 2:00 p.m. All Sellers must show their horse in the preview. Horses must be checked in prior to the preview and all paperwork completed. The sale will be held in downtown Glenrock in front of the Four Aces Supper Club, beginning promptly at 6:00 p.m.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. CWL & its associates act as agents only and are not responsible for buyer/seller error or misunderstanding. All guarantees are strictly between the buyer and seller.
2. All horses consigned to the sale must go through the ring. No Substitutions will be allowed.
3. All horses entering the ring will be sold to the highest bidder, the auctioneer will take precedence, and decisions shall be final.
4. All consignors are responsible to read the cataloged information on their horse. If any information is incorrect, the consignor is responsible to announce any necessary corrections at sale time.
5. The commission will be 8% of the selling price, or the minimum, whichever is greater of \$35. Consignor has the privilege to no sale or pass out his horse. If the horse is passed out, the cost will be the catalog fee, plus the \$50 pass out fee. The catalog fee is non-refundable.
6. Seller checks will be processed in 7 business days after the sale to ensure all paper work is secured & buyer checks have cleared.
7. All horses must have a current health certificate, negative Coggins test and brand inspection. Consignors are responsible for declaring HYPP status of Impressive bred horses, if applicable. Registration papers and signed transfers will be required day of sale.
